- 1 Wed – **IRISH CELT 1** - Pray that this will be a month of renewal both spiritually and psychically for us.
- 2 Thu – **ROBINSON** - Pray for me as I meet with some potential ministry partners in Dublin.
- 3 Fri – **IRISH CELT 2** - Two of our kids will continue karate class twice a week. Pray as we interact with these families from now through May.
- 4 Sat – **IRISH CELT 3** – PRAISE! Mr. Irish Celt has started playing soccer with a group of men on Saturday evenings. Please pray for this time, that good, solid relationships would be built.
- 5 Sun – **ROBINSON** - Pray for me as I minister through preaching in Caersalem Chapel in Caernarfon
- 6 Mon – **IRISH CELT 1**- Please pray for Irish Travelers. Pray for us as we seek God's wisdom and direction on how to minister to and reach this people group.
- 7 Tue – **IRISH CELT 2** - The older boys are back in school for the semester. Pray for our contact with the teachers, students, and other parents.
- 8 Wed – **IRISH CELT 3** – Please pray for our language learning, that we would reach a higher level of fluency in order to be able to communicate the Gospel clearly in the heart language of our friends.
- 9 Thu – **ROBINSON** - Please, pray for the leadership of the British-Irish-Celts Cluster of the IMB, as we meet in London today.
- 10 Fri – **IRISH CELT 1** - Pray for many opportunities to share about our team and what God is doing among Celtic speakers.
- 11 Sat – **IRISH CELT 2** - We continue our Irish language studies with three different local natives. Please pray we have opportunities to share the Gospel with them.
- 12 Sun – **IRISH CELT 3** – Please pray as we seek to make connections with the local

middle school in hopes of getting groups of American teens involved in cultural exchanges, school-shadow days, etc. Pray for favor and open doors.

- 13 Mon – **IRISH CELT 1** - Pray that we will maintain our friendships while being so far away.
- 14 Tue - **IRISH CELT 2** - Pray for the neighbors on our street. There is one family in particular which we have a burden for. They are about our age with 3 kids. Pray God softens their hearts to us and to the Good News.
- 15 Wed – **ROBINSON** - Please, pray for the meeting of the Evangelical Alliance of Wales joint Executive-Council meeting (or which I'm a member)
- 16 Thu – **IRISH CELT 3** – Please pray for our time with our new conversation practice partner, D. Pray that schedules would remain clear enough for us to meet together regularly, and that our conversations would go beyond conjugations and verb tenses. He has shown interest in spiritual matters before. Pray that the Spirit be moving in his heart.
- 17 Fri – **THE CELT** – Please pray and ask the Lord of the Harvest to send more workers unto the harvest. As you probably know, we utilize many, many short term volunteer and prayer-walking groups each year. These groups are strategic to the work here. We are also prayerfully hoping for God to send people to come serve long term. Please pray to this end, and seek Him on whether He would have you serve.
- 18 Sat – **IRISH CELT 2** - It seems more than ever we struggle with sinus infections and colds here. Pray that we have strength through the remaining cold months and that none of our school work or relationships suffers because of sickness.
- 19 Sun – **IRISH CELT 3** – Please pray for a deeper relationship with B, S and their children: neighbors of ours. There have been good conversations, and we want them to continue. Pray that time and schedules would allow play dates, coffees, and dinners and that He would be guiding them closer to Himself each day.
- 20 Mon – **THE CELT** – Please continue to pray against depression, Seasonal Affective Disorder and discouragement during the winter months.
- 21 Tue – **IRISH CELT 2** - We both have to take driver's education classes and then pass the driving test. Feels like being 16 again! Please pray we have no problems with this. Pray as the scheduling of the required 24 sessions of driver's ed is not easy to plan into our schedule.
- 22 Wed – **ROBINSON** - please, continue to pray that God will call out the students that we need for our various summer projects.
- 23 Thu – **IRISH CELT 1** - Pray for safe travels as we attend different conferences and have the opportunity to share.

- 24 Fri – **IRISH CELT 3** – Please pray for some of the relationships Mrs. Irish Celt has started to build through the local choir. Pray for wisdom, discernment, and open doors to deeper relationships and sharing Christ.
- 25 Sat – **THE CELT** – Our people groups speak, sing, and interact with many phrases/blessings in their heart-languages that are based, or taken straight from, Scripture. Pray that God’s word not return void, as He’s promised us, and that their eyes would be open to the truth laying in front of them everyday.
- 26 Sun – **THE CELT** – As you pray for students to fill the summer positions, pray that God would raise up Godly young men willing to come serve. The number of guys has dwindled in the past few years. The boys and teen guys desperately need positive, Godly, male role models and influences.
- 27 Mon – **THE CELT** – Please pray for spiritual and emotional health, protection and growth for all of us as we serve in the spiritual, and physical, darkness that permeates our fields of service.
- 28 Tue – **THE CELT** – Pray for the Scots Gaelic speakers of Scotland, that they would be freed from their traditions and cling to the One who can truly set them free.
- 29 Wed – **THE CELT** – We are heading into the month with the greatest number of Saints Days for all of the Celtic countries. Please pray that eyes would be open, and hearts seeking the Truth.
